SOUTHAM HALL FOYER

At this stop in the tour, you will learn about the painting's current location. This is where the audio tour begins, so be sure to begin the audio segment

here. To start the audio tour, scan the QR code provided.



THE FOUNTAIN ROOM

At the Fountain Room, you will learn about the rivalry between John Meredith and his brother William Ronald. In order to enjoy the interactive Snapchat filter you will need to scan this Snapcode from within

your Snapchat app.

1 ELGIN

This is where the Meredith piece was commissioned for in 1969. You will get to experience the painting in its original space by opening the Artivive app on your device and pointing the camera to this spot in 1 Elgin.

Meredith's painting is located on the Terrace level of the NAC, near the Al Zailback Lantern Room and the spiral stair case. directions to

THE FOUNTAIN ROOM

Proceed down the nearby stairs to the Elgin level and walk across the Mezzanine Foyer towards the fountain icon.

directions to

1 ELGIN

Proceed down the nearby staircase until you reach the Canal Level. Continue down the stairs, head straight and you will find 1 Elgin.
